Rocks is a dynamic and immersive summer camp experience designed to ignite the voices and the musical passions of young people ages 6-17 while fostering personal growth, leadership skills, and community engagement. Through teaching artists led instrument instruction (bass, drums, electronic music, guitar, keys and vocals), collaborative workshops (stage presence, songwriting, entrepreneurship, recording), inclusivity oriented panels about topics that fuel music makers, band management, guest performances and mentorship opportunities. Participants have the opportunity to explore their musical talents, connect with peers, and unleash their valuable voices.

At YEAH!, we believe in the power of music to inspire, empower, and transform lives, and we are committed to providing young people with the resources, support, and opportunities they need to succeed.

Participants will have the opportunity to work with experienced instructors and guest artists, explore different musical genres, and collaborate with their peers to create original music.
